

## **APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR CHEMICAL ENGINEERING**

Our department accepts applications on a rolling basis, however, in order to be given full consideration for admission and financial assistance, applications for **Fall semester** should be received by **January 15**.

<b>Deadline for Full Consideration for Funding (All Applicants)</b>	<b><u>Fall Semester</u></b> <b>January 15</b>	<b><u>Spring Semester</u></b> <b>September 1</b>
<b>Final Deadline for Applications</b>	Domestic – July 1 International – April 1	Domestic – December 1 International – September 15

Please apply on-line at <http://www.graduateschool.vt.edu>. There is a \$75.00 application fee. Your application will not be processed until this fee is paid. **Admission decisions can only be made when we receive a complete application.**

The university requires the following scores:

- Minimum score of **90** on the internet-based TOEFL test or
- A score of 6.5 or higher on the IELTS

\*TOEFL scores may be waived for applicants who have a degree from a US university, however, the degree must be awarded.

**GRE scores:** No minimum GRE score is required, however, listed below are averages and standard deviation of scores from students we have recently accepted. The entire application packet is considered in the review process.

**Average: Verbal: 154 / 170**  
**Standard Deviation: 7**

**Quantitative: 165 / 170**  
**5**

**Writing: 3.0 / 6.0**  
**1**

The complete application includes:

- Completed on-line application and application fee
- Electronic copy of all official transcript(s) submitted with the on-line application (Official final transcript(s) sent to the Graduate School upon acceptance)
- Official Graduate Record Examination (GRE) test scores (Institution code for submission of scores is **5859**. There is no department code.)
- Official TOEFL test scores or IELTS scores (*international students whose native language is not English or do not have a degree from a US university*)
- Three (3) letters of recommendation (provide e-mail addresses of references when completing on-line application)
- Resume and Statement of Purpose submitted with on-line application

Electronic transcripts should be legible when submitted or there may be delays in processing your application.
